## **Clinic Format:**

Day One: Morning: Rein work ~ Steering, collection and spins

Afternoon: Cattle work

Day Two: Morning: More Rein work ~ Stopping and lead changes

Afternoon: Cow work ~ Down the Fence

## **Cancellations:**

Cancellations are handled on an individual bases. **Deposits are non-refundable.** If you need to cancel for any reason we strongly encourage you to try to sell your spot. If a rider or horse becomes unable to complete the clinic, **no refund** will be given as the Ride/Clinic host or instructor cannot be responsible for unforeseen problems.

## **Video & Audiotaping:**

Video & Audiotaping needs to be cleared by SANDY COLLIER PRIOR to clinic start time.

## **Horses:**

The State of California requires all horses entering the state to have a Negative Coggins within the last 12 months. This test takes some time, so if traveling from out of state, please plan ahead. Your horse should be healthy and in good shape.

## **Horsekeeping:**

Please try to arrive before dark as it makes it easier to find your way around. The stalls are covered. If you need or want shavings they are available to purchase or you can bring your own. Bring a bucket and your feed.

**You are responsible for cleaning your own stall daily and before you leave. If stalls are not clean upon departure you will be charged an additional \$25.00.**

## **Hay:**

If you need to purchase hay, the local feed store, Shasta Feed 530-347-6033 has good quality Hay.

## **Directions to Cottonwood Creek Equestrian Center**

Cottonwood is located between Redding & Red Bluff on Interstate 5. From I 5 Take Bowman Road exit. Go West on Bowman Rd. for 3 miles. Turn Right on Evergreen Road. Go 1 mile. We are on the right – Sign out front - you can see the covered arena from the road.
